The first deadline for applicants outside of the European Union is <u>March 1</u>. For residents of any Member State of the European Union, the application deadline is <u>June 15</u>.

Admission Requirements:

The basic requirement for admission to the LL.M. programme is the **possession of a law degree** which entitles the holder to practise law in his/her country of origin. Because of the great variety of systems of legal education, the Board of the Centre for Advanced Legal Studies reserves the right to decide which degrees or diplomas give access to the programme.

(1) TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), for which the minimum score required is 250 (the Centre for Advanced Legal Studies' TOEFL code number is 0716, which should be entered on the answer sheets when taking the TOEFL test and should also be indicated on the Score Report Request Forms); (2) the IELTS administered test (International English Language Testing System), for which the minimum score required is 7.5 and (3) Cambridge test, Profiency level.

Additional information:

The tuition fee does not cover any costs of food, accommodation, books, etc. It is estimated that the living expenses for one academic year (10 months) of study in Leuven are approximately 7.870 Euro for a single student and 13.960 Euro for a married couple without children.
