Admission requirements:

An Upper Second Class Bachelor's Degree in Law (or a degree with a substantial legal component) is normally required, but account may also be taken of practical work experience or professional qualifications within the relevant field of study. We welcome applications from international students. Mature applicants without formal qualifications but relevant work experience are also encouraged to apply. Where applicable, English language ability to level 6.5 in IELTS.

Additional information:

Each module is divided into four study themes. You will be required to submit a reflective essay, demonstrating your research on each topic, at the end of each theme. You will also submit a 5,000 word assessment at the end of each module. For the award of LLM the successful completion of the four modules will be followed by a 15,000 word final dissertation.
