Additional information:

Full-time LLM students are required to complete four modules from those listed – two modules per semester. For those candidates seeking the award of LLM in Information Technology and Telecommunications Law, a 20 000 word dissertation on a topic of your own choice is required. Distance learning students are also required to complete four modules, taking one module per semester.
