Greek northern borders are one of the main Europe's backdoors for sex traffickers, while Greece has been convicted twice for violating the Art. 4 of the ECHR in cases of sexually exploited women victims of THB. The A4 Project builds upon the Convictions under the Art. 4 aiming to enhance perpetrators' accountability for the protection of women and girl victims of sex trafficking through a police-led resilient mechanism in the EU south-eastern border, built on a border-crossing alliance (Bulgaria-Greece) constructively interconnected with an interregional safety net (5 Northern Greek Border Regions) and advanced from the acquired knowledge of a central European country (Austria).


Steering Board Approval
