1 Introduction

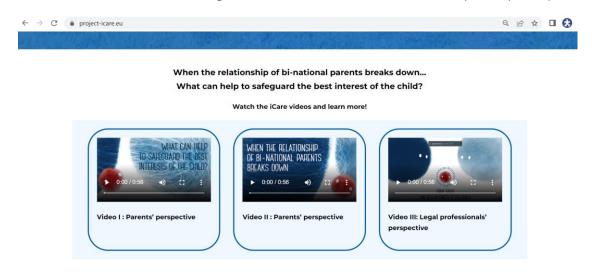






6 iCare Videos dissemination
