Fee:

A partial tuition waiver of € 7,812 is offered for non-EEA students. Students pay only € 2,484 instead of the high graduate fee of € 10,296. EEA students pay the same fee as Dutch students, which is € 1,620. € 5,000 is for the covering of living expenses for one academic year, both for EEA and non-EEA students.

Application information:

Students can apply for admission at any time. If they apply before the dates mentioned below, they will be in time to start their studies in August. 15 April for all non-EEA applicants requiring a visa; 1 July for non-EEA applicants not requiring a visa; 1 July for EEA applicants.

Admission Requirements:

Students must have a university-level bachelor's degree. Students with a bachelor's degree in law can be admitted directly. Students with a bachelor's degree in a related scientific field can submit a request for admission to the LLM in Law and Technology. TOEFL, IELTS. Candidates must evidence a good command of English (with TOEFL or Academic IELTS results or equivalent). TOEFL or Academic IELTS minimum scores: Notes for applicants - English language skills.
