Application information:

- A printed and completed [application form](#), signed and dated by you;
- Certified/authenticated copies of your diploma(s) and transcript(s). If you have not obtained your diploma yet (but you will obtain it before the start of the program), please enclose a certified copy of your most recent transcript + a list of courses you still need to finish. If your diploma(s) and transcript(s) are not in English language, you will need to provide a sworn translation into English of these documents;
- An academic IELTS, TOEFL, Cambridge Proficiency Examination or Cambridge Advanced English certificate;
- A letter of motivation (free format);
- Your Curriculum Vitae;
- A photocopy of a valid passport (your passport should be valid at least until the end of the Master's program);
- For Chinese applicants only: Nuffic Certificate (formerly known as NESO Certificate). For information how to obtain a Nuffic Certificate, please visit the website of [NESO China](#);
- Scholarship application: If you meet the requirements for a [Tilburg University Scholarship of Academic Excellence](#) you should add the Scholarship application form.

Admission requirements:

Before applying, please make sure that you meet the following admission requirements:

- You have a Bachelor's degree in **Law** before the start of this Master's program;
- You have an adequate knowledge of English before the start of this Master's program. In order to proof your English proficiency you need to take (or have taken) one of the following tests:
 - Academic IELTS (minimum score 6.5 overall, minimum score of 6.0 on individual parts);
 - TOEFL (minimum score of 90 for the internet based test, TOEFL institutional code of Tilburg University is 9860);
 - Cambridge Proficiency Examination (CPE, score A, B or C) or Cambridge Advanced English (CAE, score A, B or C).

You are exempt for the English proficiency test if:

- a. You are a native English speaker, i.e. if you are a citizen of one of the following countries: Australia, Canada (with exception of Quebec), Ireland, New Zealand, United Kingdom and United States of America;
- b. You completed all your secondary education in English. This only applies to scholars from the following countries: Australia, Canada (with exception of Quebec), Ireland, New Zealand, United Kingdom and United States of America;
- c. You completed all your university education in English. This only applies to scholars from the following countries: Australia, Canada (with exception of Quebec), Ireland, New Zealand, United Kingdom and United States of America.
