Duration: 1,5 years; Full-time programme.

The programme is of 15 months duration, with two full semesters of lectures and tutorials (four mandatory courses in total), and the third semester devoted exclusively to the completion of a master thesis.

It is possible to finish the LL.M. degree in one year (12 months). The first semester will include two courses (which is the normal load), but the second semester will include the writing of the master thesis and two courses. The summer period should be entirely dedicated to the writing of the thesis

Fee:

There is no tuition fee for this LL.M. programme

Application information:

The deadline for submitting the online 'Request for Application Form' is 1 November.

Potential applicants must have submitted the online 'Request for Application Form' before they could receive the formal application form. The 'Requests for Application Forms' have been processed by the International Education Office and only applicants who fulfilled all the formal requirements received the online application form.

Admission Requirements:

Applicants must have completed a Bachelor of Laws Degree (LL.B.) or a recognized equivalent (in law) of at least three years duration.
